

1st Year Athletes – Instructions for joining National Governing Boards

Joining the National Governing Bodies for the various disciplines is quite easy and inexpensive if you follow the following process.

1. First year athletes can simply complete the Complimentary Membership form which will provide you with both National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) and the National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA) memberships for the current year. (See next page for form)
2. You will submit this completed form along with your registration materials.

We will take care of making sure those numbers are entered into your Commissioners Cup registration when the organizations assign them.

3. Everyone will need to join ATA to qualify to shoot trap in the Commissioners Cup this year. The cost of a Junior membership is just \$12 and can be completed by clicking on the ATA link below.
